The Board of Directors of Nanuet and Beyond thanks you for your interest in our 2022 scholarship. You will be part of our mission of providing educational experiences to the students of our communities.

APPLICANTS: As we conclude the second year of the unprecedented, ever-changing Covid-19 pandemic, we can all look back on challenges we have faced – personal, social, educational, workwise, and the pandemic’s impact on us, our families, friends, and neighbors. For the essay portion of the application, we ask that you, too, reflect on the impact Covid has had on you. We also ask that you tell us what the Nanuet and Beyond Scholarship would mean to you and your family as you prepare for the next step in your educational journey, whether college, learning a trade, or both.

In addition to the short essay described above, in order to be considered, each applicant must:

- Be a graduating senior in good standing at Nanuet High School, Clarkstown High School South, Clarkstown High School North, Albertus Magnus High School, or BOCES and reside in either the Nanuet or Clarkstown school districts.
- **Part I:** Complete and submit the application form and all required materials to your guidance counselor by **April 1**.
- **Part II:** Submit a short essay on the challenges and impact of Covid on you; what continuing your education means to you personally, as well as what winning the scholarship would mean to you and/or your family. Also, please incorporate a challenge, other than Covid, that you overcame.

SUBMIT TWO COPIES OF THE ESSAY: ONE WITH YOUR NAME ON EACH PAGE – AND ONE **WITHOUT YOUR NAME OR SCHOOL NAME VISIBLE** ANYWHERE IN THE DOCUMENT. Please staple the pages of each copy in the upper left-hand corner.

- List any extracurricular activities, honors, and awards on the application form. Activities may include school-based (clubs, sports) and/or out-of-school activities (citizenship/community volunteering/work).
- **Part III:** Submit two references: one from a teacher and one from either an employer, coach, leader of an organization you volunteer with or a peer. No family member may submit a reference. Each reference only needs to be a paragraph (150-word minimum). Those providing references should send them directly to your Guidance Department.
- **Part IV:** Provide a high school transcript.

Nanuet and Beyond scholarship applications will be judged on the following criteria:

- GPA – 20 points
- Completed Application/Documentation – 10 points
- Essay – 30 points
- References – 20 points
- Activities – 20 points
