Part VI: References

Submit two references: one from a teacher and one from either an employer, coach, leader of an organization where you volunteer, or a peer. No family member may submit a reference. Each reference only needs to be a paragraph (150-word minimum). Those providing references should send them directly to your Guidance Department.

Part VII: High School Transcript

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The application deadline is **April 10th** (to your Guidance Department), and the student awarded the grant will be notified by May 19th. Payment of the grant award will be made directly to the student's college/trade school for the benefit of their account before the fall semester. Please note, the grant is non-renewable.

After completing your parts of this application and attaching the appropriate documentation, submit all paperwork to your Guidance Counselor for certification and delivery to the Nanuet & Beyond, Inc. Grant Selection Committee.

The Applicant herewith consents that the Nanuet & Beyond, Inc. Grant Committee be fully informed as to their scholastic standing, character, and other factors that may be relevant to the application.
